



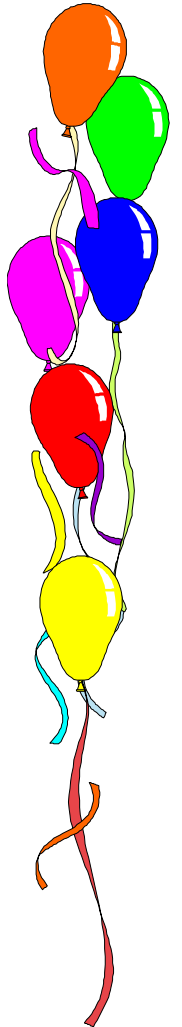
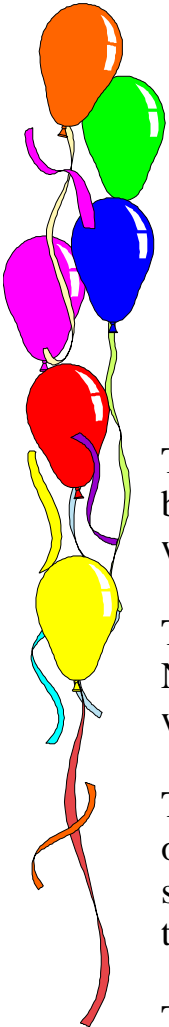
Year End? Already!

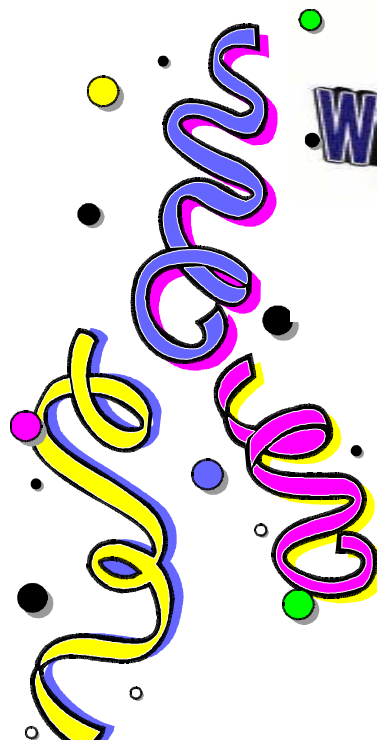
That means it is time for Wyoming Blues and Jazz Society's annual holiday bash! Please see the following article for details. This is one you will *not* want to miss!

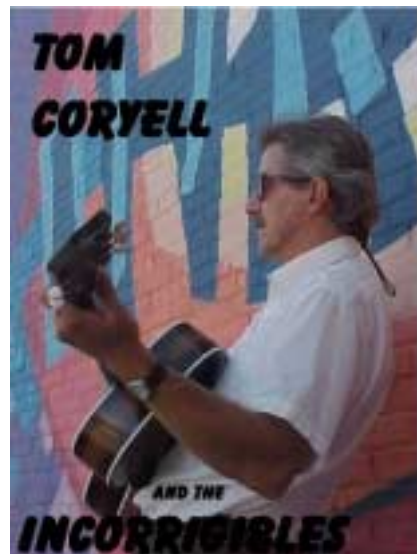
Dance to the music of The Tremors, Tom Coryell & The Incorrigibles, and JD Blues Band!

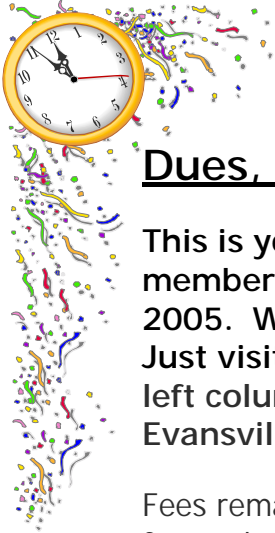
